The results are showing that for the majority of attendees, the general view of the event was very interesting, with the precise that the partners could have been more active in the discussion with the EP candidates and the national politician.

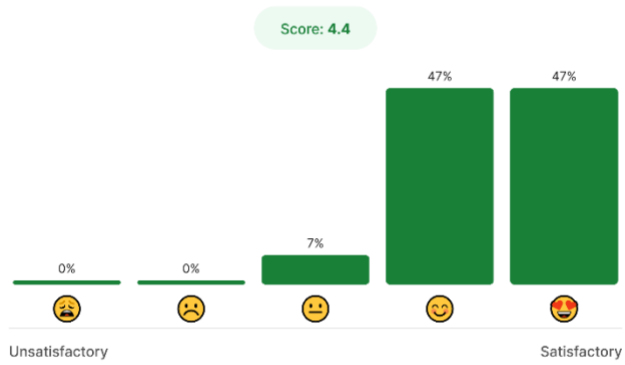
*“I like the program and that you stick to it and everything was as planned without any change so I think you couldn't do anything more. More than this is perfect.”*
